

Caring about our communities' health, safety and well-being is a paramount priority for the AHANSA Business Center. We continue to support our members both physically at the Center and virtually as our local government agencies' continue to position in place the necessary mandates and safety guidelines. However, we are proactively communicating our plan to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and other spreadable infectious diseases. We commit to our health and safety procedures and protocols to be in place and will update this page as the evolution of the spread continues, or as we receive updates from our public health agencies.

Health and Safety Protocols Throughout Our Center include:

- ✓ Floor markers will be in place to remind our members and their Visitors to keep people a safe distance
- ✓ Each person is required to wear a mask (working in a single-person office with the door closed is the only exception)
- ✓ The AHANSA Business Center team and its Security providers will foremost position a temperature check for its members at the Ground Floor of its establishment followed by the request of sharing information about their symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, headache, stuffy nose). Should they display a temperature in excess of 38 degrees or their whereabouts have included travelling, been exposed to anyone with the disease and if the answer to the question is yes, they would not be allowed to enter the space for another 14 days.
- ✓ Hand sanitizer should be used during every screening (sanitizer will be available at the screening station).
- ✓ Hand washing stations with soap will be available at the entrance and ofcourse in all the washrooms.
- ✓ Common areas, high-traffic areas, door handles, and light switches will be cleaned with sanitizer on a regular basis.
- ✓ Meeting room tables and chairs, credenzas, and remote controls will be cleaned after every meeting with sanitizer.
- ✓ Coworking stations and chairs will be cleaned after a member leaves the space.
- ✓ Members are asked to wipe down any common surface area they have touched such as the copy machine, coworking station, or lounge/kitchen countertops. Cleaning supplies will be provided.
- ✓ Open trash receptacles will be replaced by closed, foot pedal receptacles.
- ✓ Doors to washrooms will have foot openers so as to not have to use the washroom handles and remain contactless as possible.
- ✓ Washrooms will be provided with both hand dryers and paper towels for drying hands.
